I wanted to give everyone and update on some of the activities going on related to the maintenance and upkeep of the church.

There has been much discussion among council members on the condition of the stained glass windows and the storm windows in the sanctuary. Mark McKinley contacted Window Creations, a stained glass window restoration company located north of Van Wert, Ohio. A representative of Window creations visited the church and performed an extensive inspection of all the windows in the sanctuary and offices. Window Creations invited members of St. John to visit their facility to better understand the restoration process and see first hand the quality of their work.

On June 25, five council members, the church secretary and three other members traveled to Window Creations studio and factory to discuss the repairs needed to our windows and our repair options. All of us were very impressed by the level of craftsmanship and the quality products Window Creations provides. All of our stained glass windows are in need of extensive repairs which will be costly. When shown detailed photographs of the windows, it became clear to all of us that these repairs must be performed before the windows deteriorate any further.

Copies of window inspections, repair options, and costs will be provided to all members. Further discussion will take place in the upcoming weeks with a congregational meeting and vote to take place in late July. Please share any thoughts or concerns you may have with council members or myself.
